- In March 2022, Signify Health announced it would be opening a new technology centre in Galway, Ireland, with the creation of 125 jobs by the end of 2023. Some 60 talented team members have already been hired in a range of software engineering, product management and other technology development roles.
- Led by Ireland Site Lead <u>Elaine Murphy</u> the dynamic and diverse team at the technology centre in Galway are working on solving some of the most complex problems in the U.S. healthcare system. The Galway team is responsible for developing new solutions through software development, large-scale data analytics and creative problem solving.
- This is Signify Health's first base outside of the U.S. and Galway was chosen as it is a hub for technology and innovation with a thriving tech ecosystem. The Galway office is seen as another 'floor' of the Signify Health global business and is integrated entirely into the Signify Health company.
- The company initially worked from the PorterShed in Galway while its new home at Bonham Quay was being fitted out. In May 2023, the company started moving into their new offices at Bonham Quay in the heart of Galway city.
- The iconic state-of-the-art <u>Bonham Quay</u> complex overlooks Galway Docks. Signify Health believes the office is one of the first in Ireland to be purposefully designed from scratch to work as a hybrid working environment.
- Bonham Quay was developed by developer Gerry Barrett and built by SISK. It has been
 certified with a range of sustainability credentials including being certified with <u>One Planet
 Living</u>, which provides a framework for organisations who are committed to creating a truly
 sustainable workplace.
- Working with <u>SIG Workplace</u>, Signify Health has used an inclusive design that ensures that sensory stimulation is varied throughout the working day. It has been designed as a 'relationship building' which fosters collaboration.
- An emphasis was put on creating an office space that reflects the location in which the office is located – the West of Ireland – and supporting the local community, the ecosystem and showcasing the work of local artists and craftspeople.
